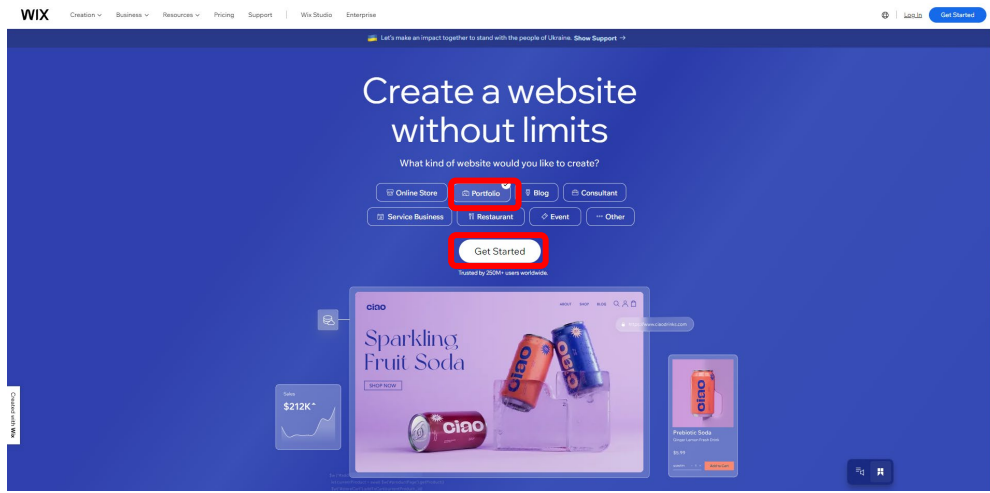

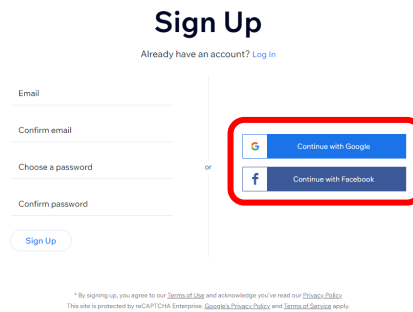
2. Getting Started with Wix

Choose **Portfolio**, and then click on **Get Started**.



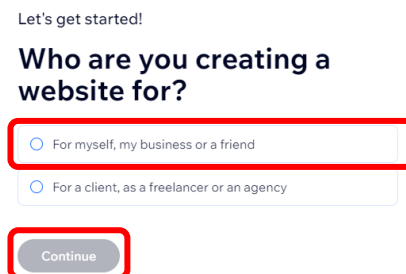




Choose "For myself, my business or a friend", and then click on **Continue**.



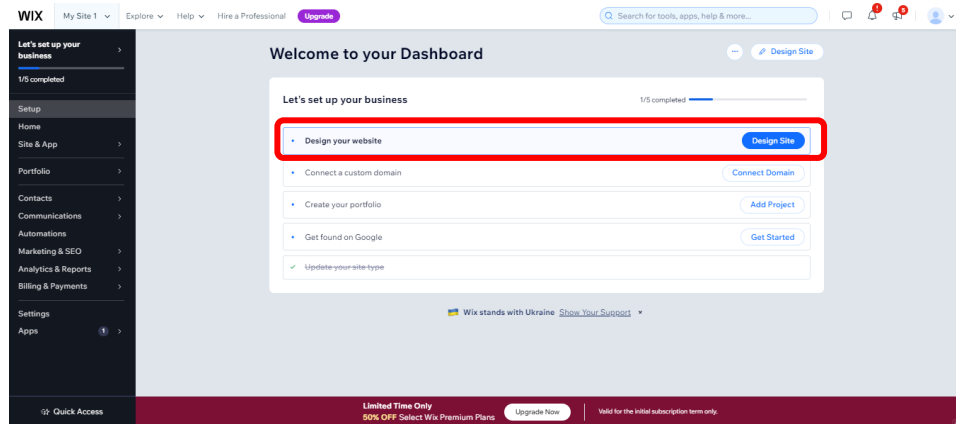


Click on **Upgrade** and then jump to the following page that show all the plans of Wix.

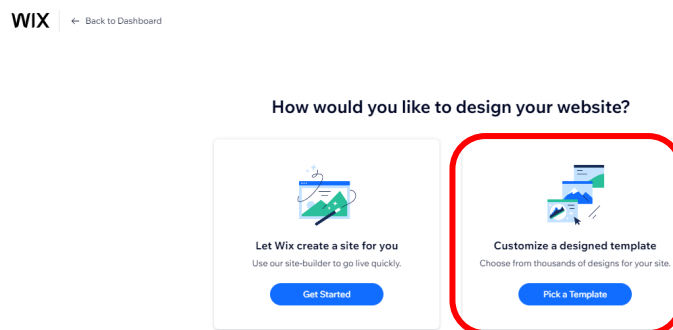


4. Selecting and Customizing a Template

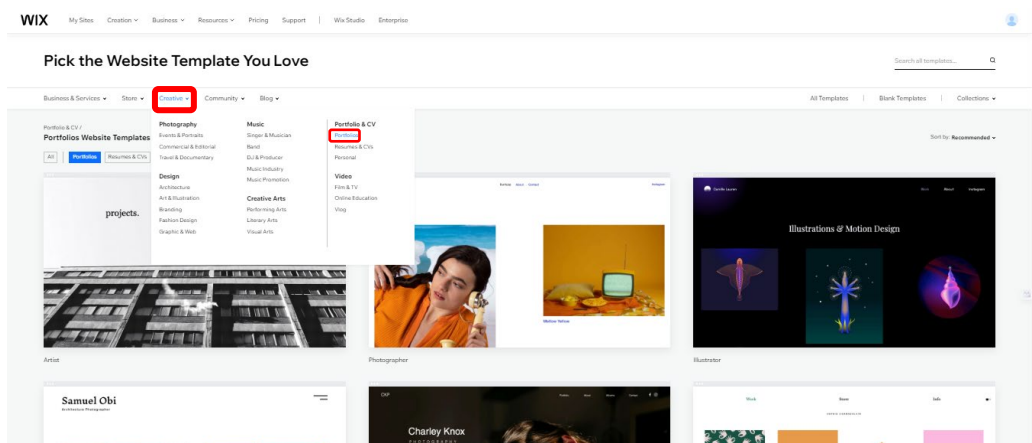
Back to the **dashboard** page, Set up and manage your Wix website. Click on **Design Site**,



Then jump to the following page, and choose “Customize a designed template”, then click on **Pick a Template**.

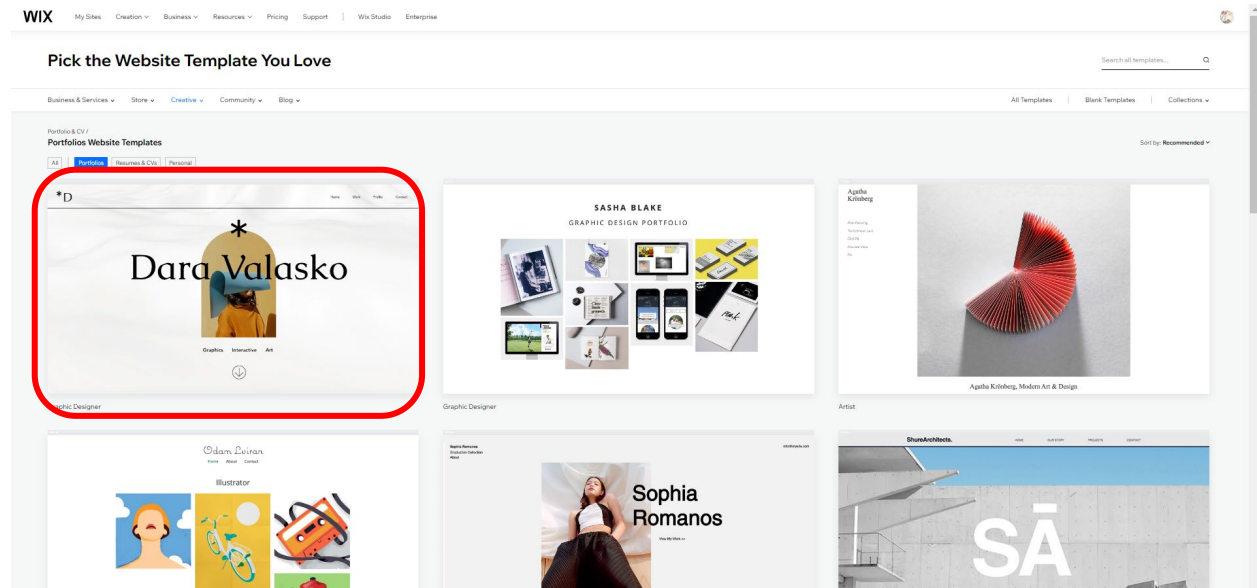


Next, jump to the following page, and choose “Creative”, then click on **Portfolios**, Drag the scroll bar up or down, then turn to the next page and pick the website template.

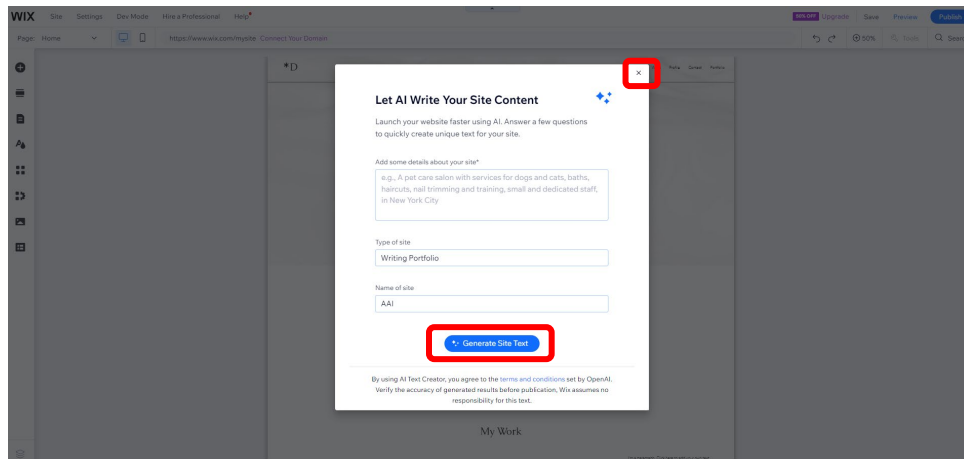


5. Adding and Organizing Portfolio Content

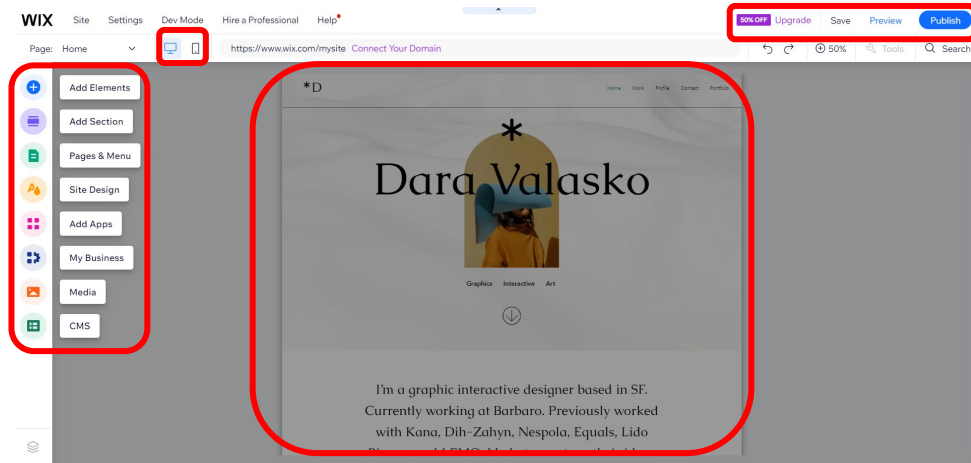
Drag the scroll bar down, find the **Branding Portfolio**, click on View.



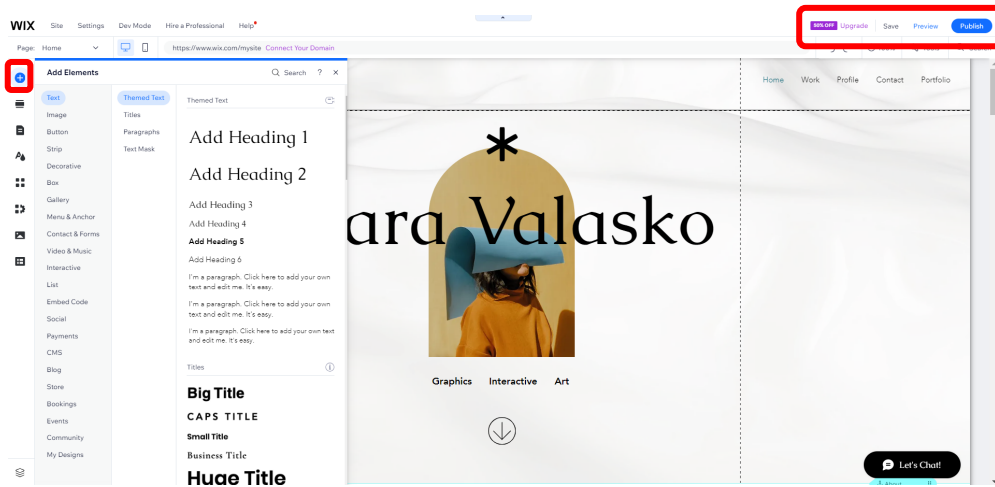
Then jump to the following page, you can add some details about your site then click on **Generate Site Text** to let AI write your content, or click on × to design the website by yourself.

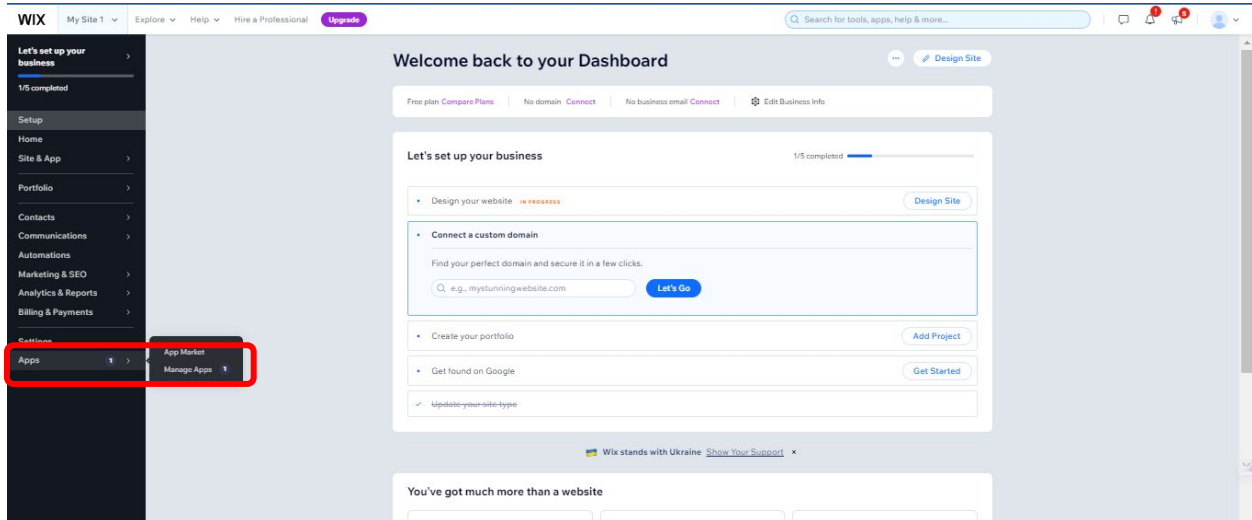


Click on **+** in the editing tool and pop up the **Add Element** menu, and then you can add Text, Image, Button, Menu & Anchor, Video & Music, and so on.

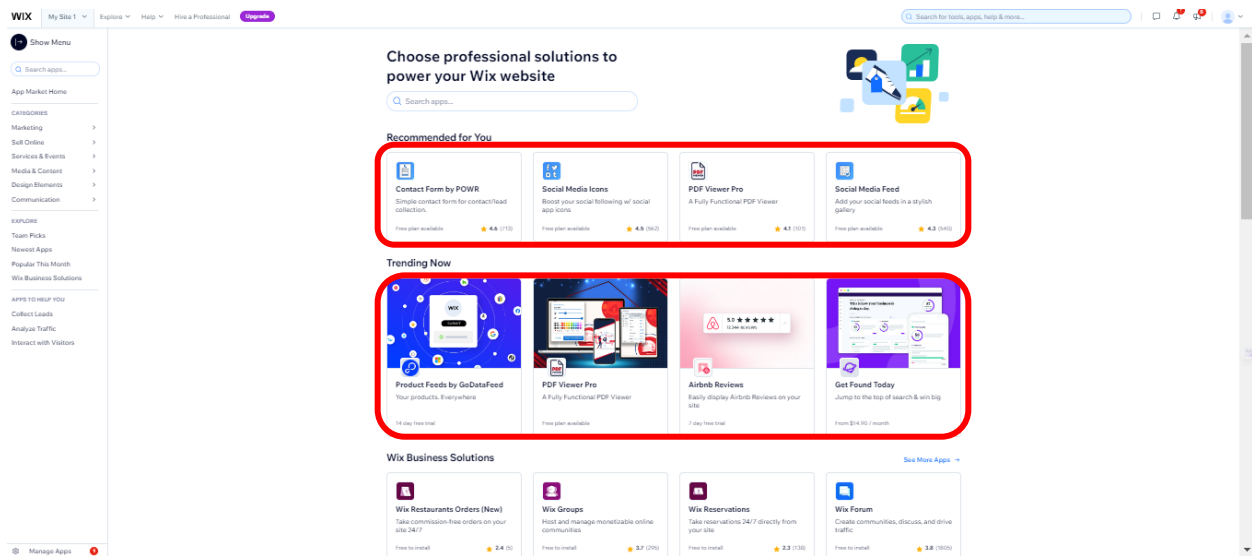


6. Enhancing Your Portfolio with Wix Apps

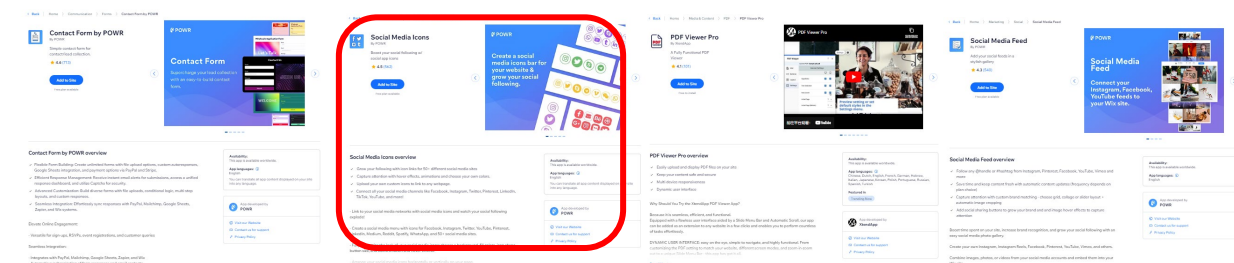
On the dashboard, choose **Apps** menu.



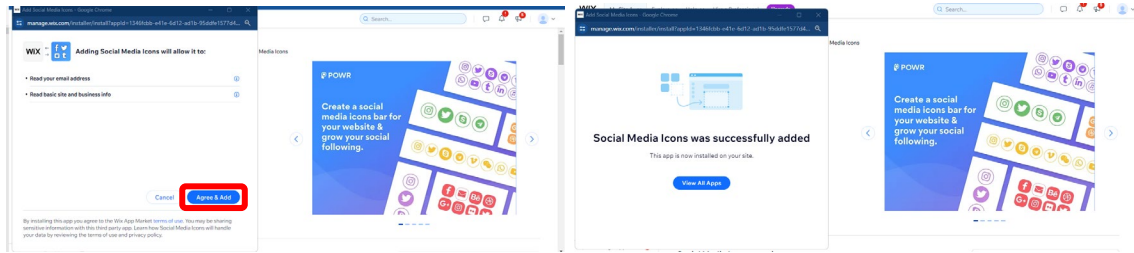
Then jump to the following page, choose an app to power your Wix website.
